In the past five years, with the support of community partners like you, Historic Athens has achieved significant preservation milestones, making it one of the most impactful periods in our 56-year history.

- Installing new Historic District signage
- Increasing ACC-UG attention to important sites
- · Expanding Hands On Historic Athens to double preservation projects for low-income homeowners
- Maintaining easement and guidance at Southern Mill
- Enhancing preservation partnerships with National and Georgia Trusts
- Convening an ACC Candidate Forum on local preservation policy
- Collaborating on a plan for the Maddox Center
- Funding historic resource surveys of Whitehall, Carr's Hill, and Newtown for new historic districts.

This remarkable progress was made possible through the support of our members, trustees, staff, volunteers, interns, and community partners.






#### **OUR STORY**

Today, we continue our multifaceted mission, focusing on education, preservation advocacy, and community enrichment.









### **OUR STORY**

The Historic Athens Equitable Home Preservation (EHP) Initiative is funded through the Athens Justice and Memory Project, led by the descendants of Linnentown. It is part of Historic Athens' ongoing commitment to preserving historic homes while ensuring equitable access to safe, comfortable housing.

The EHP program was established in 2024 with the support of ACC-UG and the Athens Justice and Memory Project. The EHP project aims to conduct up to \$25k in rehabilitation services towards historic homes over the next three years targeting 12 homes.












#### **OUR STORY**

In 1967, the founding members of Historic Athens embarked on their first historic preservation project, rescuing and restoring the oldest surviving residence in Athens, the Church-Waddel-Brumby House (c. 1820), laying the foundation for our work in preserving Athens' heritage.

The house stands meticulously restored to its 1820s appearance when Moses Waddel, President of the University of Georgia, resided there. In 1973, the site was designated Athens' official visitor information center, serving as the first stop for thousands of visitors each year.






